
- * Study to show yourself approved unto God, rightly dividing the Word of truth.
















Jesus Is Mighty





Old Testament Lessons: A Canticle of Worship

I Chronicles 28 and 29 relates the history of the building of the temple by King Solomon. When the temple was dedicated King David (solomon's father who was still living at the time) gave a Psalm of praise which is recorded in I Chron. 29:10-15.

I Chron. 29:11-13


When the Ark of the Covenant was brought into the Temple and placed in the Holy-Of-Holies, the scene is described here –


And it came to pass when the priests came out of the Holy-of-Holies, and the Levites who were the singers stood at the east end of the alter, clothed in white linen, having cymbals, stringed instruments and harps, and with them one hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets – indeed it came to pass when the trumpeters and singers were as one to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the Lord, and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, that the house of the Lord was filled with a cloud, so that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for the glory of the Lord filled the House of God.







God is working His purpose out!


All things work together for good to those who love the Lord, to those who are called according to His purpose. Romans 8:28
